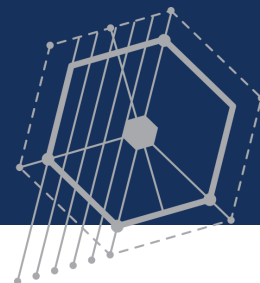

Who is eligible?

If you have sufficient documented unmet financial need and answered yes to one of the additional questions on the right, you may be eligible for funding that will **cover at least 50% of your college tuition**. Funding may be used to replace student loans for which you are eligible.

What should I do next?

1. Complete the online application for the CSD SUCCESS Scholarship at www.uky.edu/chs/success
2. Submit a FAFSA online according to Step 2 of the SUCCESS scholarship application
