

#### **OUR MISSION**

The Kentucky Congress on Spinal Cord Injury's (KCSCI) mission is to gather individuals with SCI from around the Commonwealth to join in the discussion of critical issues and to advocate for changes in Kentucky for people with SCI and paralysis. KCSCI is a program of Independence Place, Inc (IPKY). IPKY is a non-residential Center for Independent Living that provides five core services aimed at independence in the community for people with all types of disabilities:

- ADVOCACY
- INFORMATION & REFERRAL
- PEER SUPPORT
- INDEPENDENT LIVING SKILLS TRAINING
- TRANSITION

IPKY and KCSCI service delivery approaches are based on principles of the Independent Living (IL) Movement. Our aim is to create a culture where consumers become strong advocates for the rights of all people with disabilities and are willing agents who provide peer mentoring to the SCI and paralysis communities. We want to live up to the example of the founder of the IL Movement, Ed Roberts: "We're going to develop leadership, that has a fundamental difference. That is, it's inclusive. It believes in people, and in our strengths together. And we are going to change our society."

Over the past year, members of KCSCI have collaborated with IPKY staff on various community advocacy projects, as well as developed a peer mentorship program to provide support services to individuals dealing with the effects of paralysis. Through this program, KCSCI will provide volunteer peer advocates to mentor individuals affected by paralysis. Individuals with paralysis, caregivers, family, friends, and service providers are welcome to get involved with our advocacy projects and utilize these services.

The Need: Organizations, outreach programs and specialized medical care providers for individuals living with chronic spinal cord injury (SCI) in the Commonwealth of Kentucky have traditionally been unorganized and without a common mission. Importantly, while current outreach efforts appear to have some impact for individuals with SCI in urban areas, we wish to build cohesion among this community of individuals throughout the Commonwealth by expansion into the more rural areas. We envision participants, sponsors, healthcare providers and care givers all exchanging information about programs available to those in need throughout Kentucky. The community of individuals with SCI and their support systems can be a strong advocacy group given the right organizational structure.
