Goals/Objectives

- 1. Gain an understanding of articular cartilage related procedures performed by the University of Kentucky Center for Cartilage Repair and Restoration
- 2. Gain a basic understanding of patient reported outcomes used to evaluate clinical outcomes among knee surgical patients
- 3. Gain experience in the use of SOCRATES patient outcomes software, becoming proficient in data entry and export
- 4. Observe clinical research in action in an active Sports Medicine Clinic

Tasks for completing objectives (with timelines)

- 3. Assist with data entry of patient reported outcomes and operative reports in SOCRATES patient outcomes software as directed
